

How to Draw Lips



Step 1 - Outline shape



Step 2 - Add lines for shadow



Step 3 - Add more lines leaving areas white for reflected light. Lines on left curve in a gentle "c" and on the right in a backwards "c," away from the center



Step 4 - Lightly shade areas with a rounded pencil point. Rub tissue over the lips to blend. Use an eraser to bring out the highlights.

Fun Lip Facts:

1. Lips are 100 times more sensitive than your fingers. This is because there are millions of nerve endings around the lips and they have no protective tissue, which makes them very sensitive.
2. Everyone's lip mark is unique - just like our finger prints.
