Peter and the Wolf Concentration Card Game

Listening to the symphonic composition *Peter and the Wolf* by Sergei Prokofiev is a great way to learn about different instruments in the classical orchestra. After listening to the symphony, use this set of cards in a game of concentration to help learn which instruments correspond to which characters in the story. Matching numbers in the upper hand corner will help provide a clue if you forget.

To play: Print out one or two copies of this handout. Cut out the individual cards and paste them to small rectangles of cardstock or paperboard so the image can't be read on the backside. Shuffle the cards and arrange them in a grid, cardstock side up. Then, test your memory by flipping over cards one at a time, as you try to make a correct pairing of characters with their corresponding instruments. Once you make a successful pair, it can be removed from the grid. Keep attempting to make accurate pairs till all of the cards are matched. Make it a competitive game by playing with a friend and taking turns!
