

Salt Dough Cookie Ornaments

Celebrate National Cookie Day on December 4th by making your own cookie ornaments using salt dough!

Steps:

1. In large bowl, mix together your salt and flour.
2. Gradually stir in water.
3. Knead the dough until smooth.
4. Roll the dough to a 1/4" thickness and cut out shapes with cookie cutters. Punch a hole in the top for a string.
5. Lay on an ungreased baking sheet. Bake at 250 for two hours. Let them cool before decorating.
6. Decorate however you want! Then, tie a string or ribbon through the hole at the top and hang on your tree!

Ingredients:

1/2 cup salt
1 cup flour
1/2 cup water

Other:

Paint/glitter
Ribbon/string



Cut, color, and decorate these cookie shapes!
