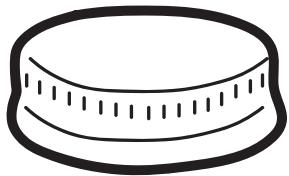
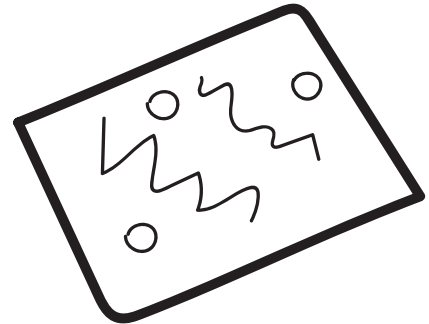


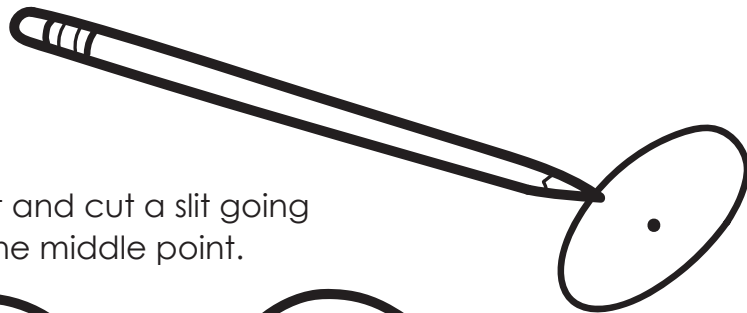
National Umbrella Day

It's raining really hard, so you look for an umbrella. Oh no, you can't find one! Good thing you can make one! Follow instructions below for making a paper umbrella.

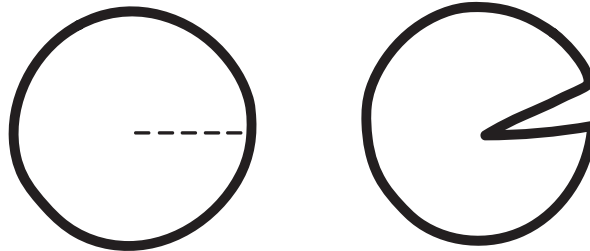
1 Choose some colorful paper for your umbrella.



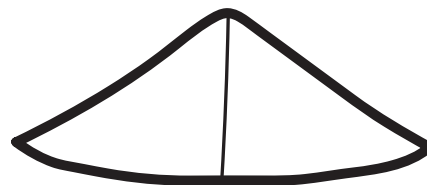
Find a jar lid that is around 3 inches wide and trace it on the paper with a pencil. Cut out circle and erase pencil marks. **2**



3 Find the middle point and cut a slit going from outer edge to the middle point.



Take the edges of the slit, then overlap them until the paper starts to form a shallow cone shape. **4**



5 Glue the slit edges together. Glue stick is best.



Flip cone over and place a drop of hot glue into middle. Place end of toothpick or stick into glue and hold for a minute. **6**
