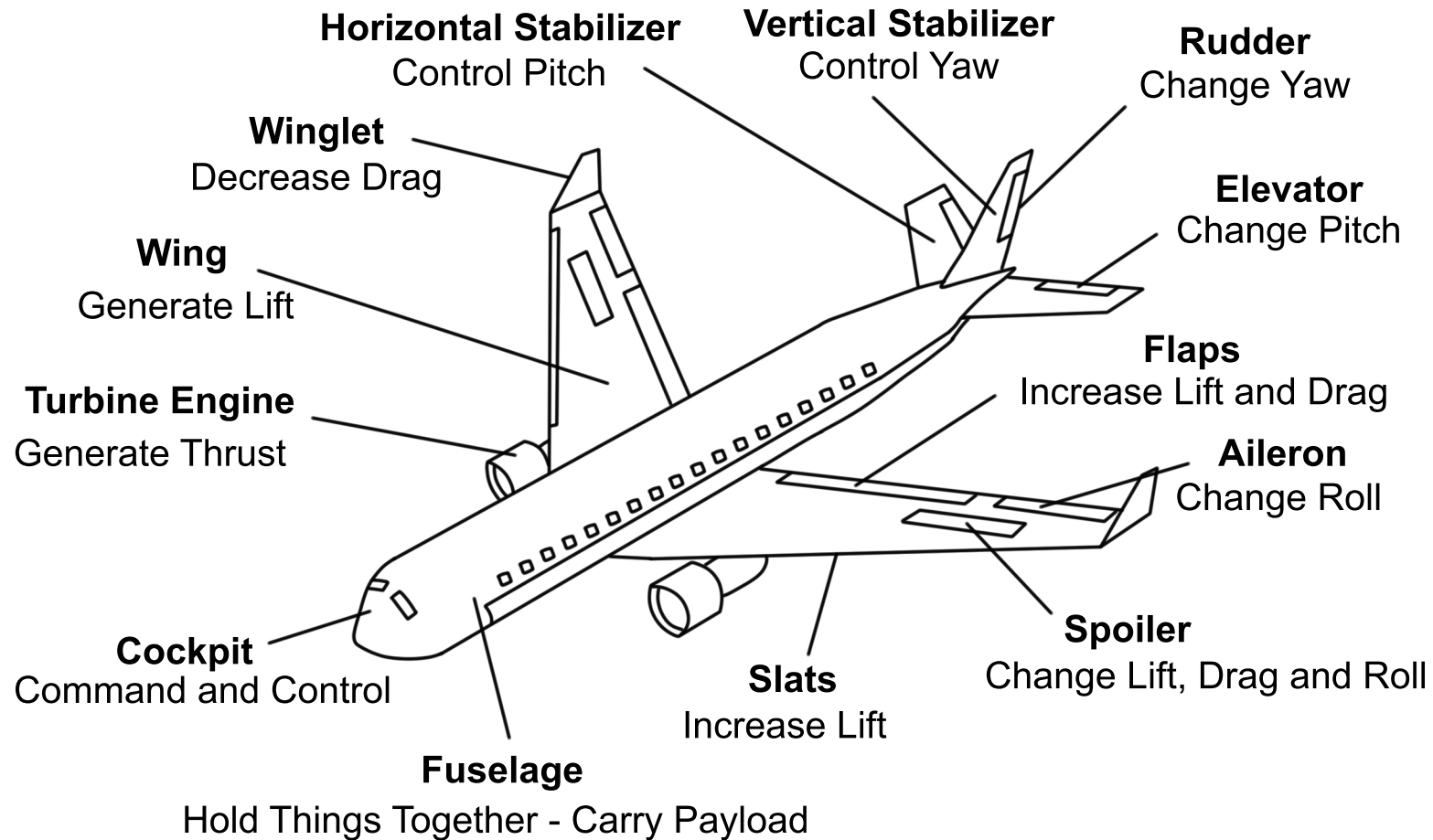


Learn Airplane Parts and Functions



Learn more vocabulary:

Pitch - The rotation of the airplane around a left-to-right axis (think of the airplane nodding up and down)

Drag - The force that resists movement of an aircraft through the air (this force can be used to push the airplane upward)

Thrust - A force that moves an airplane in the direction of the motion (created by the propellers or engines)

Lift - The upward force on the wings that opposes the weight of the airplane (this keeps the plane in the air)

Roll - The rotation of the airplane around itself (think of the airplane twisting)

Yaw - The rotation of the airplane around an up-and-down axis (think of the airplane turning left and right like a car)
