


Make Your Own Seed Paper!


Tear your construction paper into small pieces, making a small pile. Throw the construction paper into the blender with a little bit of water. Blend.



Pour into a bowl and add the seeds. Mix.



Spread your seed paper paste onto the strainer. Pat down and leave drying overnight in a place with little sunlight with a towel underneath to soak up the excess water.



Remove seed paper from surface once it is dry. You are ready to plant!

Alternative method: Place a towel on the table. Using the cookie cutter (or bracelet), fill it with seed paper paste and pat down. Leave dry in a place with little sunlight so that the seeds don't sprout.
