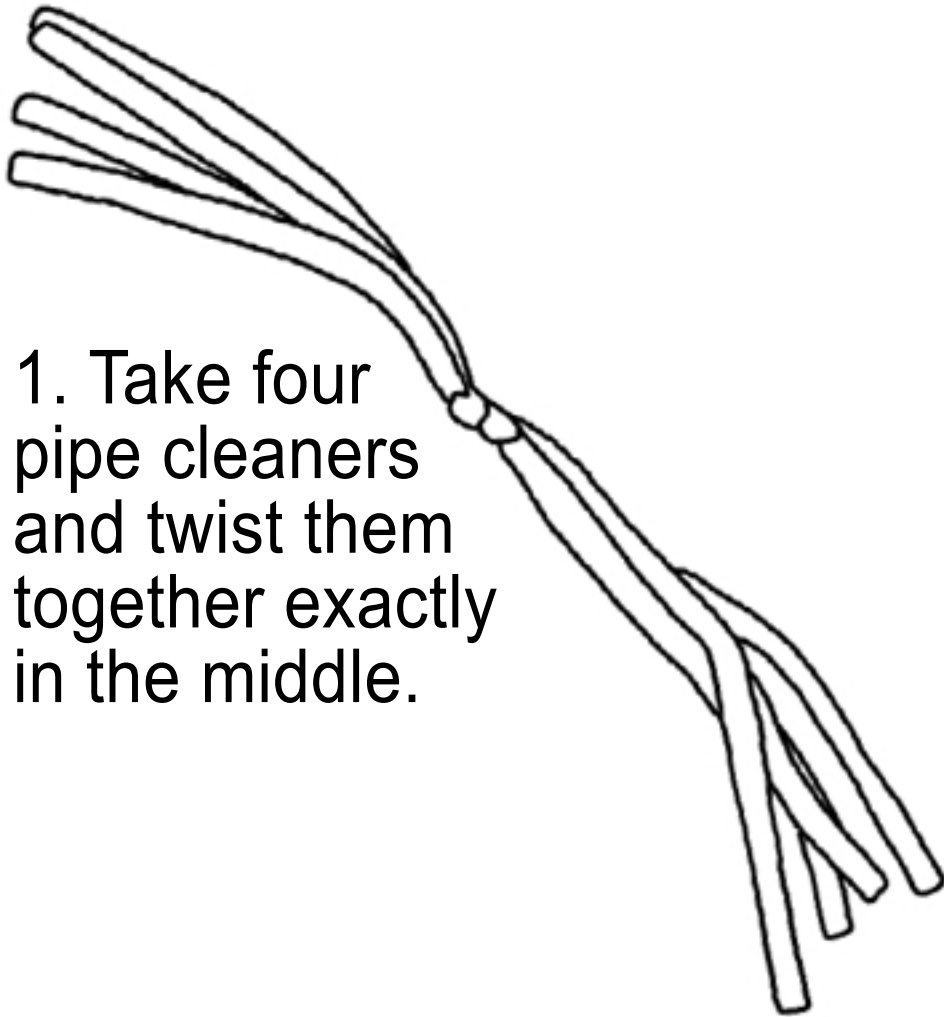


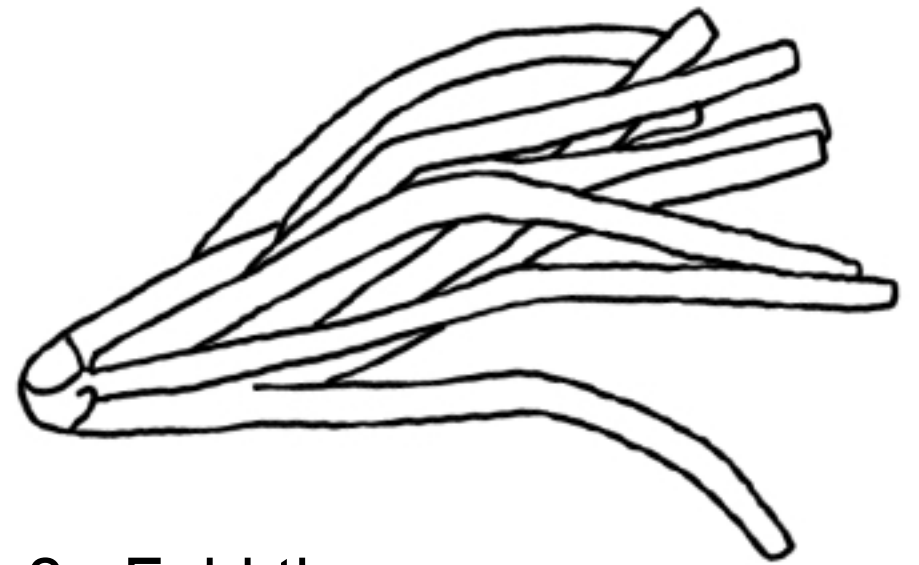
# Calico Corn Craft

Calico corn (also called flint corn), is a type of maize with hard, colorful kernels. It was one of the many types of corn cultivated by the Native Americans.

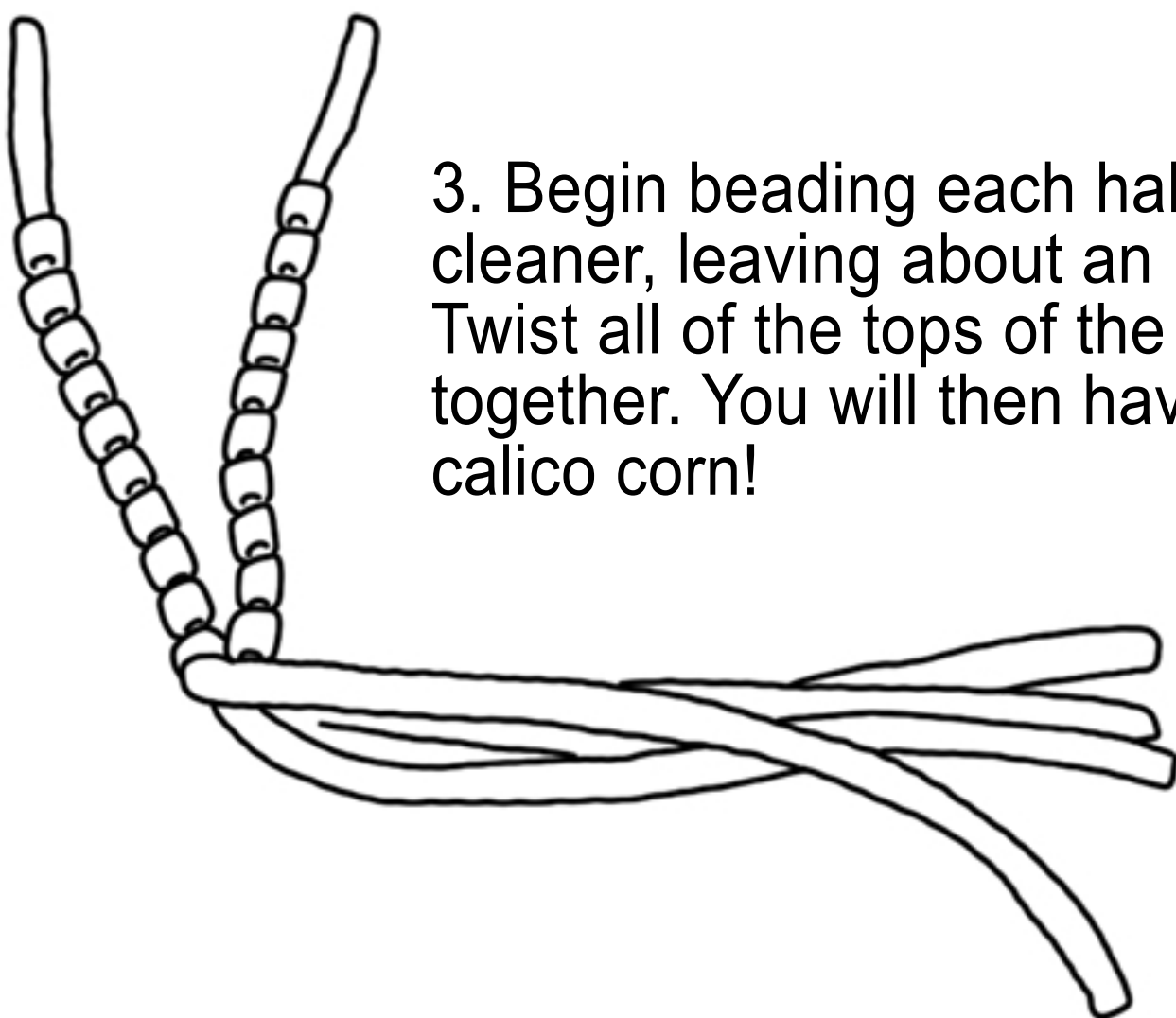
Four pipe cleaners (of any color, most likely a husk color like green, brown, or yellow) and many (at least 50) multi-color pony beads and/or plastic bracelet beads.



1. Take four pipe cleaners and twist them together exactly in the middle.



2. Fold them together to make a 'V'.



3. Begin beading each half of each pipe cleaner, leaving about an inch at the top. Twist all of the tops of the pipe cleaners together. You will then have your calico corn!
