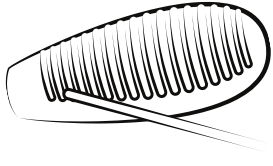


Guiro Handout

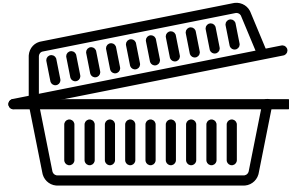


The güiro (Spanish pronunciation: [ˈgwiro]) is a Latin American percussion instrument consisting of an open-ended, hollow gourd with parallel notches cut in one side. It is played by rubbing a stick or tines along the notches to produce a ratchet sound.

Hoagie container



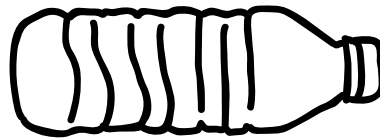
or

or

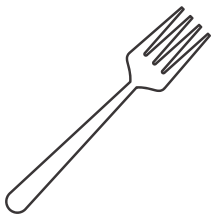


Take out container

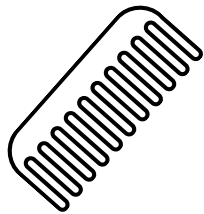


Plastic bottle

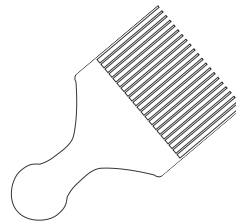
You can take the Guiro and experiment with sound variations using items that you might have at your home:
