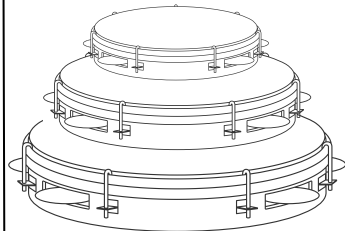


Pandero Handout

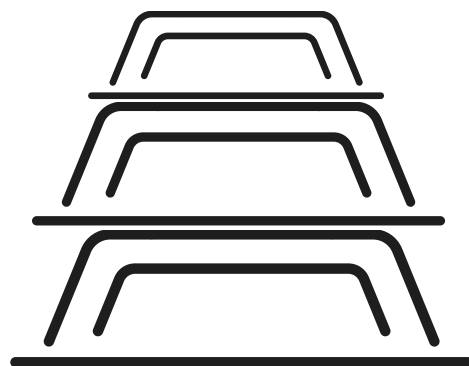


The Pandero is similar to a tambourine but without the metal jingles. A group of these drums is commonly used in traditional Puerto Rican plena music. The smallest is called primo or requinto (small), then segundo or seguidor (medium), and tercero, bajo or tumbador (large). Each one has a distinctive sound and way to play it. You may also hear that some people call these instruments pleneras, because they are use in plena music.

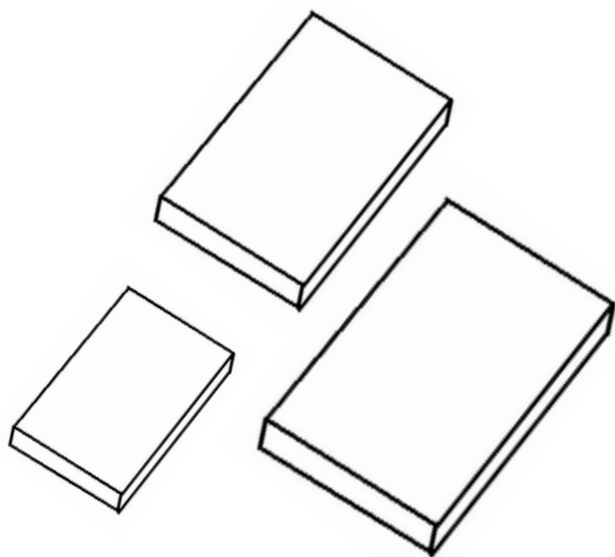
Use these recyclables to make your own Panderos



3 sizes of plastic take-out container bases or lids

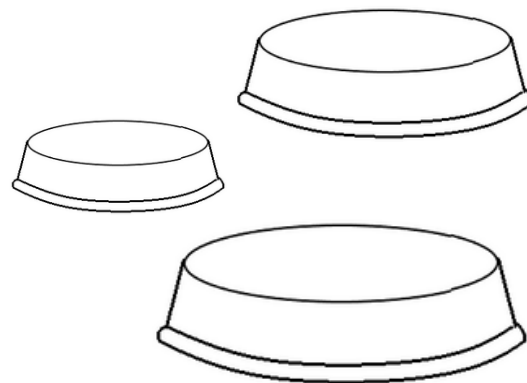
