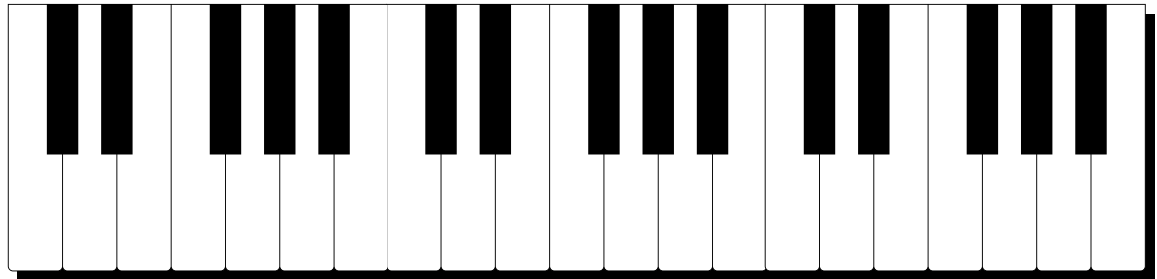


Names of the White Keys



Directions: Study the keys then fold the paper in half and fill it in by memory. All you have to remember is that the white keys on the piano are named after the first seven letters of the alphabet: A, B, C, D, E, F, and G. The musical alphabet starts with the letter C, not A because C is the most basic note in music. Repeat the alphabet for remaining keys so the last key will end on a B.
